Stricter compliance mandates are driving employers to proactively screen employees as protection against future claims for pre-existing conditions. From 2011 to 2019, injuries from falls increased 41%, while the number of nonfatal injuries rose 8%.


The 20-24 age group ranked highest among workers who experienced a nonfatal injury that resulted in days away from work (Brown 2021) at a rate of 150.8 per 10,000 FTEs. Education continues to be one of the most important elements as newer businesses and employees have the most injuries in the industry.

Many construction projects also lack internal resources or have difficulty staffing positions with qualified health professionals to provide worksite medical services, assess hazards, and implement health and safety measures and controls.

Additionally, they must remain compliant with regulations affecting their workforce. Non-compliance may result in OSHA citations and monetary penalties thereby impacting an organization's ability to bid on future projects.
