Background

Challenge

The U.S. government and military officials strive to implement high-quality healthcare for deployed personnel, yet they face several barriers when self-performing medical services, including:

- Inability to deliver, scale, and sustain end-to-end medical solutions in areas challenged by geography, conflict, and geopolitics.
- Shortage of medically qualified employees and staffing resources.

Acuity's Expeditionary Medical Solutions support 13,000 patients per month across a variety of environments and use cases, including:

- Base Operations Network Support (Iraq): An embedded team of 2,100 staff support base operations in Iraq. Acuity also provides medical, staff, and hospital management services in both Afghanistan and Iraq.
- Medical Evacuation, Personnel Recovery, and Search and Rescue Services: Medical exam services for a population of 10,000 employees.
- Casualty Evacuations and Transportation Services (Yemen): Serving a population of 150 in Yemen.


